Teams accepted for participation in 2017

Moto3™ and Moto2™ Classes

Teams wishing to benefit from a Participation Agreement with IRTA had a deadline of the British GP to submit their applications. As usual, there were considerably more applications than places available.

Applications were considered during several meetings of the Selection Committee and participation has now been confirmed with teams who will supply 31 riders in the Moto3 Class and 32 riders in the Moto2 class.

Listed below are the teams accepted in each class together with the number of entries and the brand of machine to be used.

In order not to anticipate media announcements by the teams, no names of the riders are included. A final entry list, including names of riders, will be published by the FIM in the week preceding the Valencia GP.
